Move.T+ is a youth association and our aim is as simple as to build a better world, one day at a time. We are about 50 members aged between 16 and 32 years with the desire to promote social, cultural, sport and educational activities to the local community. Our name incites everyone to move, and it reflects our common passion to create activities that add value to the people and the city, inspiring and encouraging youth movement and initiative.

We want to promote an active citizenship, greater social cohesion, awareness on relevant community issues, and a fairer society, supportive and motivated to share experiences and join efforts towards a better world. Considering the specific personal and professional skills of each member, we have structured our activities into three main components: education & health promotion, civic & cultural intervention, and sports & environment.

The scope of our activities extends to the general population, in order to raise awareness about social, cultural, environmental and other relevant issues to promote active citizenship and shared responsibility in building a better world.







Project summary

In this Partnership Building Activity, we will develop projects Dissolving Discrimination through sports. We intend to find creative usage and good practices of using sport as a tool for enhancing inclusion and active citizenship.

We are to exchange and learn from each other while enhancing our capacities and quality of work

Therefore, our aim is to identify and establish possible future long-term cooperation with the selected partner organizations and collaborate in increasing the number of projects aiming at Dissolving Discrimination through sports in Erasmus+ funded projects throughout Europe and beyond.

The greater goal of the project is also to improve the amount and variety of usage of sport-based methods as a NFE educational tool serving Dissolving Discrimination under Erasmus+programmes.

Hence contributing to promote and implement social inclusion, antidiscrimination and active citizenship-oriented mindset and projects be it at local, national and international level too.

In this PBA we want to bring together 28 youth workers from 14 different countries working in non-profit organizations.

Expected results: Providing a meeting point to bring together 28 youth workers/leaders/managers of organizations for future collaborations on Dissolving Discrimination through sports projects such as training course creation, strategic partnership and collaborative partnerships creation.

We will be designing at least 7 projects (training course, collaborative and strategic partnership) to be applied in 2021 deadlines.

The project is designed for youth workers and youth leaders active in their organizations who are to build successful partnership and are aware on how these partnerships can be linked to the strategic priorities of their organizations.







Project objectives

- 1. Strengthen the motivation and increase cooperation between youth organizations internationally interested in the topic of Dissolving Discrimination through sports
- 2. Provide a space to learn and share good practices and experience on the usage of sport as a tool for Dissolving Discrimination in youth work.
- 3. Create the space for contact making and networking as a base of future projects with special focus on the usage of sport as a tool for social inclusion, antidiscrimination and active citizenship.
- 4. Foster quality improvement in organizations social contribution by developing projects using sport as a tool to Dissolve Discrimination.
- 5. Encourage and develop the creation of future projects within Erasmus+ framework.
- 6. The project will contribute to the objectives of Erasmus+ by:
 - a) Improving the quality of youth work by promoting and strengthening European cooperation between youth organizations and relevant stakeholders focusing on the usage of sport as a tool for Dissolving Discrimination.
 - b) It will enhance the opportunity of mobility of youth workers and leaders including the ones with fewer opportunities.
 - c) It is to capitalise on sharing best practices while discovering and building future collaborations on developing projects on European dimension for Dissolving Discrimination with sport as a tool to it.
 - d) To promote and implement social inclusion, antidiscrimination and active citizenshiporiented projects to be implemented in the future.







Participants profile

The number of participants per institution is present in the reimbursement table below.

For each group of participants, there should be numerical **gender equality** in order to ensure gender balance as well as between different sensibilities and life trajectories. All participants must know the basics for communicating in English.

The following specific criteria was established for the selection of the participants:

- youth trainers/workers/leaders active in their organizations in project management/organization and writing (minimum 1 year!);
- Strongly motivated to get more involved in the development of social inclusive sport activities;
- Preference for participants coming from a fewer opportunities background;
- Preferably participants who have some kind of experience in project development;
- Gender balance, select equal number of male and female participants.

Please select experienced participants who are active at management level in your organization and have preferably decision-making power.

Be aware that our insurance only covers personal accidents and the activities proposed, during your stay in Guimarães.

All the amounts foreseen by the project have been calculated according to the official address of each organization. So, the distance calculation has been made following the official distance calculator of the European Commission².

For the reimbursement it is essential to travel directly in the most economical and feasible way, without any longer stop-over from hometown to Guimarães in order to arrive and depart on the given project dates.

All the requested documents serve as supporting documentation for the Project's Final Report (and reimbursement).

The organisers will reimburse for the unit travel cost using the rules of the Erasmus+ from the home city to Guimarães and from Guimarães back home. (we will NOT cover insurance, taxi or car).

PLEASE NOTE all prices need to be accepted by the coordinator before any purchase is made, a screenshot from the website can be sent to us in advance and we will approve or decline within 3 days, all attempts will be made to answer these emails as soon as possible. Tickets purchased without prior consent could result in no reimbursement for travel costs!

Travel reimbursements information

Reimbursement of your travel costs can only be done upon submitting ALL the original tickets, invoices, boarding passes tags, etc. - or upon submitting us the payment evidence along with the original ticket or e-ticket (with the boarding pass wherever applicable).

To be reimbursed, the participants need to take part in all the duration of the training course and all the activities.

All the tickets bought with a different currency from EURO will be converted to EUR according to the following rules:

- Beneficiaries with general accounts in a currency other than the euro must convert costs incurred in another currency into euros at the average of the daily exchange rates published in the C series of the Official Journal of the European Union, determined over the corresponding reporting period (available at http://www.ecb.europa.eu/stats/exchange/eurofxref/html/index.en.html).
- If no daily euro exchange rate is published in the Official Journal of the European Union for the currency in question, conversion must be made at the average of the monthly accounting rates established by the Commission and published on its website (http://ec.europa.eu/budget/contracts_grants/info_contracts/inforeuro/inforeuro_ en.cfm), determined over the corresponding reporting period.

Reimbursement will be done in EURO, so beneficiaries with general accounts not in euros must convert costs incurred in another currency into euros in accordance with their usual accounting practices.

The reimbursements will be done through bank transfer to one account number for each partner organization upon receiving all the original tickets, invoices and boarding tags.

You must keep a copy of all printed tickets and boarding passes so that we are able to reimburse you the costs.

Whenever possible, buy the return tickets and bring the invoice.

PLEASE NOTE: The organizers will not provide any accommodation for additional stay in Portugal.

If participants plan to arrive a 1 day earlier or depart 1 day later, they are kindly requested to inform organisers and to justify its reason before buying any ticket!

We need to contact our National Agency for the approval upon which we will be glad to assist with necessary arrangements.







How to get to Guimarães

The quickest and easiest way to get to Guimarães is flying to Oporto's airport. You could also fly to Lisbon, but it would be more difficult to get to Guimarães.

From Oporto's airport

When in Oporto's airport, we suggest you to get a bus called "getBus", it would take you directly to Guimarães BUS station, where you will be picked.

The meeting point will be in front of the hostel at 18h.








Guimarães in a Map








From Bus Station to Hostel

About Guimarães

Guimarães is a city and municipality located in northern Portugal, in the district of Braga. Its historic town centre is listed as UNESCO World Heritage Site since 2001, in recognition for being an exceptionally well-preserved and authentic example of the evolution of a medieval settlement into a modern town in Europe.

For some decades, Guimarães was the capital of the County of Portugal, however, shortly after the Battle of São Mamede (1128), and due to the needs of the Reconquista, Coimbra became the kingdom's capital.

The inhabitants of Guimarães are often called "Vimaranenses" and "Conquistadores" (the Conquerors) in relation with the historical heritage of the conquest initiated in Guimarães.
